

MS Dress Code Grades 6, 7 and 8

In a day of slovenly and careless dress, it is beneficial to our Christian testimony that CAWNY maintain certain standards of refinement. As stated in the Code of Conduct, CAWNY emphasizes the development of self-discipline and submission to authority as well as the assertion that attendance at CAWNY is a privilege and not a right. Students are expected to abide by the spirit of as well as the letter of the law. In general, clothing should be chosen that is modest and CONSERVATIVE in cut and fit, as well as clean and neatly pressed in appearance. Although some modern styles may fit this code, it is quite possible they will not.

The Academy reserves the right to make all final judgments in the interpretation of the dress code.

Wednesday – Chapel Dress– This code applies to Wednesday and other designated days. Boys will wear navy, black or khaki dress slacks with a conservative solid white button down dress shirt, matching tie, and belt. Girls will wear solid color navy, black, or khaki skirts (or dress slacks) that fall below the knee when standing and a white button down blouse. Chapel day shirts and blouses must always be tucked in.

Monday, Tuesday, Thursdays and Fridays

Shirts

CAWNY logo polo shirts – purchased at school \$11.00 each

Pants

*Navy, black, or khaki two pocket pleated dress pants. No logos, no cargo pockets

*Navy, black, or khaki skirts that fall below the knee when standing

Belts

*Black or brown belts are required daily with pants.

Socks

*Solid color socks or nylons (girls) must be worn daily. Must be seen above the shoe

Hoodie – Must be purchased at school

Shoes

*Any dark color shoe, hard or soft sole. Tennis shoes may worn as a substitute for the shoe, they must be completely black with no logos. Must be neat and clean. No open front shoes.

Shorts and capri pants (September, May, June)

Pleated or flat front. No baggy, wide leg style. Hem of shorts to be no shorter than the knee. Must fit at waist not below. No draw string waists. No stretch fabric. Solid color navy, black, khaki. May not be worn on Chapel day.

Hair

*Boys are expected to have their hair cut so the back length does not come over the collar and the sideburns may be no longer than the earlobe. (clean shaven) Girls must keep their hair out of their eyes at all times in the classroom.

*Extremes in hair styles and colors, faddish, unnatural or multicolored hair coloring or cuts are not acceptable.

*Hair must be kept neat and clean at all times.

EXCEPTIONS – The following are some examples of attire boys and girls cannot wear (not to be deemed a conclusive listing):

*Tshirts under dress shirts/blouses that contain colors, writing, or pictures showing through.

*Tatoos permanent or temporary

*Tight fitting, excessively loose fitting clothing

*Sweat bands, dog collars and similar neck, wallet, or wrist chains. Buttons or pins on clothing not school related

*Fishnet or unconservative stockings. Slits in skirts above the knee.

*Outdoor jackets and or gloves are not to be worn in the classroom at any time.

*Any body piercing other than earrings for girls (in their ears)

*Nail polish that does not complement the outfit and is extreme in color (e.g. black, metallic, etc.)

*Nail polish or any kind of body piercing on boys
