CHECKLIST FOR PACKING AND WHAT TO BRING

Everyone

- · 1 Backpack or small bag (NO SUITCASES)
- Hairbrush or comb
- · Small bottle of shampoo and conditioner
- Soap
- · Deodorant
- · Bug spray/bug bracelets
- Toothpaste
- Toothbrush
- · Bathing suit (see below for gender-specific guidelines)
- · Shorts at least to the fingertip, t-shirts and tank tops are ok if weather is warm.
- · Please bring a hoodie and jeans or sweatpants for the evenings or hikes.
- · Remember socks and undergarments
- · Snacks Keep all snack in Ziploc Bags
- · Sleeping bag and pillow
- · Sneakers or extra sneakers in a case a pair get wet. OLD SNEAKERS ARE BEST!
- · Pajamas (Girls: No half shirt, short shorts, or short night gowns. Remember this is *camping* and you should dress for camping.)
- No knives

Girls

One-piece bathing suit with no cleavage showing and full coverage in the back, no thongs or half cut. If you have a bikini, you must always wear a non-see-through T-shirt over the bikini that covers the entire bikini.

Boys

- · No Speedos or thongs. Wear traditional bathing suit shorts.
- No knives

RULES

- STUDENTS MUST ADHERE TO ALL RULES SET BY THE CAMP, THEIR STAFF AND, ALL CAWNY CHAPERONES.
- · Students must not leave their groups without permission of their chaperones.
- Students must not leave the cabins after lights out. Any students out of their cabins without permission is considered "sneaking out." Any student caught "sneaking out" of the cabins will be <u>expelled</u> from camp immediately. It is the parents' responsibility to come and get them from the camp. Further discipline will be handled by the school.
- NO drugs, alcohol, tobacco, vapes will be tolerated. Students caught with these items will be immediately expelled from camp. Again, it is the parents' or guardians' responsibility to come and pick their child up from camp. Further discipline will be handled by the school.
- · All <u>backpacks/items</u> will be inspected before camp to help prevent inappropriate items from going to camp. Any items that are illegal at school are illegal for a school trip and will immediately result in suspension.
- No refunds will be given for ANY cause of suspension or removal from attending camp due to behavior or possession or usage of substances listed above.
- · All students attending <u>must be in good academic standing</u> to attend camp.
- · Camp is intended for fun, team bonding, and to be enjoyed by all. Please do not hinder anyone's experience at camp. We expect everyone to have a great time. Bullying, fighting and insubordination will not be tolerated. Removal from camp at the discretion of the staff would be based on infraction and severity.
- All <u>medications</u> must be labeled, and directions must be sent along with a note stating permission for the staff to give medication to the child. This includes inhalers and EpiPens.
- · No living creatures may be brought back from the camp. No dead ones either.

Please arrive at school by <u>8 a.m. Tuesday morning</u>. You will be back at school by <u>2 p.m. on Thursday</u> for parent pick up from school or to take the bus.
